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Hello and welcome

NEPRO³ is the new and improved solution for the procurement of professional services; it is the only solution of its kind within the UK public sector marketplace.

This guide has been designed to help you get started with the NEPRO³ solution. It explains important information you need to know including, NEPRO³ benefits, the Bloom tender process, NEPRO³ categories, pricing information, and, how to access the solution.

NEPRO³ overview

The faster compliant alternative to traditional public sector frameworks

NEPRO³ is an OJEU compliant procurement framework which assists the UK public sector to buy and manage specialist professional services from a choice of regional and national suppliers. It allows buyers to move quickly and at the lowest possible cost, whilst achieving better outcomes.

Bloom Procurement Services have been the UK's exclusive operator of the NEPRO solution, on behalf of NEPO (the North East Procurement Organisation), since its original inception in 2012. NEPRO³ is the third evolution of the solution which will open up procurement opportunities for public sector buyers and suppliers alike.

NEPRO³ will deliver substantial savings to the public sector. On average, public sector buyers currently using the NEPRO solution save between 11% and 19% based on route and against budget.

For suppliers, NEPRO³ will open up the market, removing the traditional barriers of marketing and selling to public sector bodies. The advantage to suppliers, especially smaller SMEs and VCSEs (voluntary, community and social enterprises), is that once they are registered and accredited with NEPRO³ they no longer have to go through time-consuming pre-qualification stages, instead they compete on a level playing field against larger suppliers for contracts they might not otherwise have access to.

The evolution of NEPRO

In 2011, NEPO, in collaboration with the NEPO Member Authorities, found an opportunity to procure specialist professional services in a different way. At the time, the sourcing of specialist professional services had unclear parameters and budget visibility which was leading to high levels of public sector expenditure and inefficiency.

The original NEPRO solution was launched by NEPO in 2012 to give public sector buyers access to a constantly evolving supply chain, whilst providing efficiency savings and a compliant route to market. Public sector spend through the original NEPRO solution totalled an annual expenditure of £25m.

Following the success of the original solution, NEPRO² was launched in 2015 with a new focus of promoting the solution further across the wider public sector and removing the typical barriers to entry for the national supply chain. A total of **330** public sector buying organisations have accessed NEPRO² with a combined expenditure of **£0.5 billion** - 70% of that expenditure delivered by SMEs.

Launched in September 2019 NEPRO³ will continue to address all core requirements of NEPRO and NEPRO² however, as the third evolution of the solution, a greater focus will be given to public sector buyer and supplier communities. NEPRO³ will allow participating buying organisations to communicate, share best practices and solve common problems. The supply chain will also be encouraged to collaborate and work together, to access and deliver against the more strategic and complex requirements.

Bloom has been the UK's exclusive operator of the NEPRO solution since its original inception and will continue to operate NEPRO³ throughout the lifetime of the solution.

Compliance:

This solution has been arranged in accordance with the Public Contracts Regulations 2015 and followed NEPO's standard gateway procedure. The solution has also been procured against the expectations of external funding bodies.

Duration of NEPRO³:

The solution agreement will cover from 01/09/2019 to 30/08/2023. There will be an option for 2 x 2-year extensions.

Who can use NEPRO³?

The solution is available to every public sector organisation in the UK including local authorities, housing associations, central government departments, NHS trusts, emergency services, not-for-profit and education.

Technology platform:

All projects are managed via Bloom's cloud-based project management system Pro-vide 2.0. Pro-vide 2.0 is a purpose-built online sourcing and project management system with real-time reporting and management information. The platform is a hub where public sector buyers and professional services suppliers come together to manage and report on projects.

The NEPRO³ solution is delivered by Bloom with category experts on hand to ensure access to the all relevant information to enable end-to-end project delivery and success:

- Full end-to-end marketplace solution for the procurement, contract management and payment of all professional services.
- The ability to work with regional and national suppliers.
- Buyers only pay when work is completed to their satisfaction.
- Mini-competition or direct award routes.

NEPRO³ solution scope

The NEPRO³ procurement process is fully OJEU compliant and every step is auditable, from business case, to approvals, to supplier performance.

The role of Bloom is to deliver successful outcomes. Bloom helps buyers to create the best project specification, ensuring milestones and outcomes are clearly defined. Bloom also helps buyers select the right supplier from an exclusive community of thousands of pre-accredited providers, who are paid only when a project is delivered to expectations.

To suppliers, NEPRO³ offers an efficient route to genuine public sector business opportunities across the UK. All Bloom suppliers go through a simple yet robust accreditation process.

NEPRO³ is available across 20 categories and over 340 sub-categories of professional services spend. All contractual obligations are defined and agreed upfront, which provides peace of mind and a full audit trail for governance.



Benefits of using NEPRO³

NEPRO is the faster, compliant alternative to traditional public sector frameworks for specialist professional services. The vast knowledge, expertise and data that has been obtained since the solution launched in 2012 has been used to enhance the NEPRO³ offering:

- **New category offering:** Under NEPRO² 19 categories and 240 sub-categories of spend were available, NEPRO³ has been expanded to 20 categories of spend with over 340 sub-categories. The new category 'Commercialisation and Public Sector Services' has been made available to support commercialisation and income generation across the public sector. The new category is aimed at public sector organisations seeking to develop and create areas of expertise or distinct services which could be traded, enabling them to effectively develop their approaches to trading and export locally, regionally or nationally.
- **Upgraded technology to improve user experience:** Bloom are dedicated to investing in technology to provide the best procurement route. To meet the specification requirements of NEPRO³ Bloom have launched an upgraded technology platform – Pro-vidé 2.0. This will enable robust and tailored supplier and buyer on-boarding and ongoing management, whilst providing enhanced functionality for spend controls, spend management, specification development, evaluation and payment.
- **New simplified supplier accreditation process:** Pro-Vide 2 offers a simple yet robust tiered supplier accreditation process covering standard, enhanced and construction projects, allowing easier access for SMEs and the 3rd Sector.
- **New payment terms:** The NEPRO³ call-off agreement stipulates a 'pay when paid plus 14 day' process which means suppliers will get paid more quickly. The only exception to this is for construction projects which will have a standard 30 day payment term.
- **Additional levels of compliance:** NEPRO³ has been procured in line with external funding body expectations. The process followed enables specialist professional services to be procured using external funding, supported by your own legal guidance.
- **Access to the buyer community:** With NEPRO³ buyers will have access to thousands of tried and tested specifications offering opportunities to benefit from lessons learned and to work collaboratively on future projects.
- **Social Value:** Through Bloom's innovative 'Supporting Growth Beyond Giving' strategy, a UK 3rd sector professional services marketplace will be created for NEPRO³. The concept of 'growth beyond giving' is built upon ensuring that 3rd sector organisations are fairly represented within the supply chain, with a focus on improving economic viability and reducing reliance on grants and fundraising.

How to access NEPRO³

When a buying organisation chooses to procure services via NEPRO³, they first sign up as an Associate Member of NEPO. Associate Membership with NEPO is free of charge and provides UK public sector bodies with access to NEPO's extensive range of solutions. To sign up, an online form is available on the NEPO website www.nepo.org

The buying organisation then enters into a Call-Off contract with Bloom (the exclusive operator of the NEPRO³ solution). These contractual terms and conditions are agreed from the outset; so only need to be signed once.

The entire process is quick and easy.

Your procurement options

Mini-competitions

With a mini-competition, Bloom will engage with the marketplace and identify suppliers with the skills and experience to deliver your expected outcomes, bringing new suppliers in if needed, to deliver your project. Mini-competitions allow you to get the most competitive price for a solution that meets your specific needs.

The mini-competition process begins with your statement of requirements, which Bloom can help you create. If you choose a Mini-Competition, Bloom will present you with a selection of the most relevant suppliers that meet your needs, allowing you to choose without any sales pressure.

With a mini-competition, Bloom can take you from first contact to multiple supplier proposals in as little as ten days.

Direct Awards

There may be occasions where you need to appoint a supplier directly. This might include an existing or niche supplier offering services integral to a project or where significant cost implications or service disruptions have been identified through other routes.

A Direct Award can be made in just five days. If this is your preferred route, Bloom will work with you to define your needs and develop a statement of requirements based upon the best outcomes for your project. Bloom offer a fully managed service to on-board and manage your existing suppliers, ensuring they are fully accredited.

The Bloom tender process

The entire tender process is managed online, via Bloom's cloud based project management system – Pro-vide 2.0

Step 1: The Buyer submits their requirements to Bloom. The tender is released to the selected supplier(s).



Step 2: The supplier(s) confirm their Expression of Interest (EOI) and indicate their intent to bid / no-bid the opportunity.



Step 3: Supplier(s) submit their proposals to Bloom. The response must include any project specific variations for the buyer to consider, and can only be accepted providing the supplier(s) is fully accredited.



Step 4: The proposals are evaluated by Bloom in conjunction with the buyer and the preferred supplier is selected. The buyer provides notifications of award and may provide feedback to Bloom; which is distributed to suppliers.



Step 5: Once Bloom receives a purchase order (PO) from the buyer, Bloom will draft the work order (WO) based on the supplier's submitted proposal; incorporating any agreed variations.



Step 6: The award process involves obtaining acceptance of the WO from all three parties:

- The WO is authorised internally by Bloom, which is then sent to the buyer for review and acceptance.
- The buyer approves and accepts the WO.
- The WO comes back to Bloom and is forwarded to the supplier for review and acceptance.
- Once this process is complete, the supplier will be able to begin delivering services.



Step 7: After the supplier has signed the WO, delivery of services can begin:

- To get paid, the supplier outlines the deliverables/project specific outcomes met on the Service Delivery Plan (SDP) .
- The buyer is notified that an SDP has been raised and provided the buyer is happy that the work has been completed to an acceptable standard, the buyer approves the SDP.
- Buyer approval of the SDP triggers the payment terms. An invoice is automatically generated and Bloom pay the supplier within the agreed payment terms.

Pricing information

Suppliers are not charged for registration, accreditation or participation in bid opportunities.

Bloom charge a 5% management fee to all accredited suppliers for any work undertaken through the NEPRO³ solution. The 5% management fee will remain fixed for all projects throughout the life of NEPRO³.

Bloom provides a high-touch, end-to-end service including full delivery assurance and payment processing for each project.

Bloom ensure suppliers are aware of opportunities with current buyers, and offer a fast, compliant route for services to be procured by the rest of the UK public sector.

Supplier accreditation

Bloom provide three accreditation levels for NEPRO³: Standard, Enhanced and Construction & Engineering. The accreditation levels ensure that NEPRO³ is accessible to all suppliers, big or small and are appropriate to relevant projects.

Standard Accreditation

Criteria: Project value no greater than £75,000 and/or term no greater than 12 months.

Minimum requirements:

- Registered company name and address.
- VAT number and Certificate of Incorporation (if applicable).
- One case study and supporting reference for each category the supplier wishes to be accredited against.
- Minimum Professional Indemnity Insurance coverage of £1m.
- GDPR compliance.

Enhanced Accreditation

Criteria: Project value greater than £75,000.

Minimum requirements:

- Registered company name and address.
- VAT number and Certificate of Incorporation (if applicable).
- One supporting reference and two case studies for each category the supplier wishes to be accredited against.
- Minimum Professional Indemnity Insurance coverage of £2m.
- GDPR compliance.

Construction and Engineering Accreditation

Criteria: All projects within the Construction, Design and Engineering category.

Minimum Requirements:

- Registered company name and address.
- VAT number and Certificate of Incorporation (if applicable).
- One supporting reference and one case study for each category the supplier wishes to be accredited against.
- Minimum Professional Indemnity Insurance coverage of £5m.
- GDPR compliance.
- Evidence of: Health and safety (including training) policy, Work equipment procedure policy, First aid policy, Risk assessment and COSHH assessment policy, Accident reporting policy, Fire risk assessment policy, Electrical safety policy, Manual handling assessment policy.

Technology platform: Pro-vidé 2.0

All NEPRO³ projects are managed online with complete control and transparency through Bloom's user-friendly cloud-based project management system, Pro-vidé 2.0.

Pro-vidé 2.0 is at the heart of Bloom's collaborative approach and gives buyer and supplier communities one common place to manage projects, leading to better connections and better outcomes.

Through Pro-vidé 2.0, Bloom have developed a central database of all project information and knowledge. This database has been designed to share information and best practice throughout the duration of NEPRO³. The database will educate and inform future projects for continuous improvement purposes and facilitate future collaboration between buying organisations.

Pro-vidé 2.0 streamlines the entire procurement process from initial customer request, through the sourcing process and subsequent project delivery, right through to project completion. Through regular project updates and reports, you can be sure milestones are hit and quality is assured.
